- Sessions will be 55 minutes long at 10:00, 11:00, 12:30, and 1:30 pm.
- Come for one session or up to four – same cost.
- Registration fee - \$10.00. (Please bring bag lunch.)
- All materials will be supplied (unless noted).
- Parents are encouraged to attend to help your child make a project, but project participation is for youth only.

1. **Welcome Snowman Sled** – Paint a cute snowman sled using a sponge and paint brushes. (Takes two sessions to complete.)
2. **Stamping/Scrapbooking Mania** – It will be a Stamping/Scrapbooking frenzy as we explore different uses for rubber stamps and create a scrapbook box. (Participants need to bring 5-6 photos that can be trimmed to a 4 inch square.)
3. **Light Bulb Ornament** – We will be recycling light bulbs by painting them to be a bird or snowman ornament.
4. **Leathercraft** – Participants will learn basic leathercraft stamping through the creation of two or more projects.
5. **Beginner Knitting** – Learn how to cast on stitches, how to knit and purl, and how to bind off stitches.
6. **Beginner Crocheting** – Learn how to hold a hook, and make chain, single, and double crochet stitches.
7. **Embroidery** – Learn basic crewel embroidery stitches to start a small picture.
8. **Hydrogel Slime** – Use hydrogel technology (found in baby diapers) to make colorful slime.
9. **Archery** – Learn about ecology, wildlife, and hunting and make a primitive arrow for display.
10. **Explore 4-H** – Discover all that 4-H has to offer by building a mobile around 4-H projects and activities that interest you. Parents are encouraged to attend.
11. **Egg Craft** – You will be making either a person or animal using a plastic egg and other craft items.
12. **Origami Balloons** – You will be folding two different types of balloon using patterned or solid color paper.
13. **Woven Pencil Holder Can** – You will be weaving pipe cleaners and then attaching them to a tin can to make a decorative pencil holder.
14. **Lions and Tigers and Zebras, OH MY!** – We will be creating felt zoo animal hand puppets and foam refrigerator magnets.
15. **Decorated Seed Starter** – Make indoor seed starters from recycled material and decorate with handmade bugs. Then plant your seeds for spring gardening.
16. **Making Pen Pals** – Turn a pen into a personalized “pal” using embroidery floss, glue, and beads.
