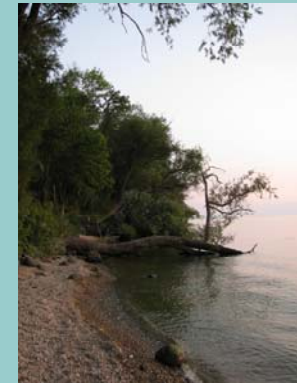
Panel presenters representing neighboring communities will also be part of the program.
