Free disposal of the following household hazardous wastes:

- Solvents
 - Pesticides & Herbicides
 - Rodent Baits & Poisons
 - Lead/Oil Based Paints **(Latex Paint NOT ACCEPTED)**
 - Spray Paints
 - Dioxin Materials
 - Gasoline
 - Waste Oil
 - Anti-freeze
 - Other Hazardous Waste
- Keep individual materials in their separate containers. **DO NOT MIX!**
 - Containers must be **5 gallons** in size or less. **CONTAINERS ARE NOT RETURNED.**
 - When transporting to the collection site, place materials in a cardboard box.
